Purpose

The purpose of the Women in the Law Committee is to provide opportunities for women in the legal profession to broaden their knowledge of issues that relate to and impact the Connecticut legal community. The committee provides those women with a forum to discuss concerns facing them in their practices and to network with others in an open environment. The committee is also engaged in promoting the objectives of the CBA and in disseminating information concerning legislation that may have a substantive effect upon the practice of law.

Annual Report

The committee was represented this year at the Central Connecticut Paralegal Association's Annual Meeting, where the chair moderated a symposium on women in the law. The speakers included women in the judiciary, education, corporate and private practice, and law enforcement. The balance of the committee's efforts this year were concentrated in disseminating legislative reports, referenda, and other information concerning issues and events that impact women engaged in law and business throughout the state.
