

AAC INTERNATIONAL JURISDICTION

Section 1 (new) - The Superior Court shall have jurisdiction of any civil action by a person for a tort only, committed in violation of the law of nations or a treaty of the United States.

Section 2 (new) - The Superior Court shall hear such civil actions only if:

- a. One or more plaintiff resides in the State of Connecticut;
- b. One or more defendant resides in the State of Connecticut;
- c. The harm was felt within the State of Connecticut;
- d. One or more defendant was personally served within the State of Connecticut;
- e. The act in question took place within the State of Connecticut;
- f. International law confers universal jurisdiction to adjudicate the act in question; or
- g. One or more defendant owns property located within the State of Connecticut.
