Program Info: To be eligible for LAW Camp, students must be planning to attend a Connecticut high school in the 2023-24 academic year and cannot have previously attended LAW Camp. LAW Camp is a one-week virtual summer camp sponsored by the Connecticut Bar Association's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee. LAW Camp offers students a unique opportunity to learn about the legal profession and develop critical and analytical thinking skills. During the week-long day camp, attendees will hear from practicing lawyers or judges, observe court proceedings, receive advocacy training, and participate in mock court exercises.

The CBA provides LAW Camp as a community service program. There is no cost to attend LAW Camp. Submitting an application does not guarantee a spot in LAW Camp; there are a limited number of spots available. The Program Committee will make acceptance decisions based on applications; preference may be given to students from communities that are traditionally underrepresented in the legal profession or who do not have financial resources available to pay for private summer camp.
