***AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE EFFECTS OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING POLICIES IN THE STATE.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Housing shall  
2 conduct a study of the affordable housing policies, as set forth in section  
3 8-30g of the general statutes, and the effects of such policies in the state,  
4 to identify any recommended amendments to said section to improve  
5 affordable housing opportunities for residents in the state. Not later  
6 than January 1, 2023, the commissioner shall submit a report, in  
7 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
8 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
9 cognizance of matters relating to housing containing the findings of  
10 such study and any recommended legislation.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
