The Young Lawyers Section is sponsoring a group admissions program to the United States Supreme Court. Ceremonies for admission to the Supreme Court are scheduled for Monday, April 6, 2015. Our last Supreme Court admissions program was well-received and filled up very quickly. ***Please note that this program is strictly limited to 50 applicants and is open to any CBA member.*** The limit of 50 applicants will be based upon the first 50 registrations received. All other registrations that are received will be put on a waiting list. The pre-registration form is due no later than January 20, 2015, along with a \$150 registration fee that will cover the expenses for breakfast and a champagne lunch following the ceremony in Washington, D.C. The form can be found by visiting the online calendar at [www.ctbar.org](http://www.ctbar.org), where you will also submit the registration fee. Upon receipt of the pre-registration form, you will receive information on the formal application process. The Supreme Court charges a separate \$200 admission fee that will be due when you submit your application.

## Qualifications for Admission

To qualify for admission to the bar of the Supreme Court, you must have been admitted to practice in the highest court of a state, commonwealth, territory, possession, or the District of Columbia since January 2012. You must supply a current, original certificate of good standing from the court where you were admitted. Additionally, you must supply a personal history sheet signed by two designated sponsors that you have met with.

## Registration Fee

### **\$150 - Attorney Registration Fee (non-refundable)**

Includes pre-registration/application processing, breakfast, and a champagne luncheon immediately following the admissions ceremony.

### **\$100 - Spouse/Guest Registration Fee**

Includes breakfast and a champagne luncheon immediately following the admissions ceremony.

## Supreme Court Fee

### **\$200 - Supreme Court Admission Fee**

This fee is due with your application, no later than February 13, 2015. Please mail or hand deliver to Carol DeJohn.

## Hotel Accommodations

The Hyatt Regency Washington on Capitol Hill will be our headquarters for this program. It is conveniently located within walking distance to most points of interest in our nation's capital, including the Supreme Court.

Room reservations must be made in advance directly with the hotel no later than Friday, March 6, 2015. Reservation requests received after the cut-off date will be based on availability at the hotel's prevailing rates and will be credited to the group's guest room block. Room rates are \$159 for a single or double.

## Guests at the Supreme Court Admissions Ceremony

Supreme Court rules provide that only one guest per admittee will be allowed into the courtroom to observe the ceremony. This policy is strictly enforced. Cameras are absolutely not allowed. If you bring a camera, you will be required to leave it in an unattended room during the ceremony. Children under six years of age will not be admitted.

Those who are not staying at the Hyatt must plan to arrive at the United States Supreme Court no later than 8:45 a.m. on Monday morning.
