This is in response to your Rules Committee referral of September 22<sup>nd</sup>, pertaining to whether or not automobile "black box" data recorders should be incorporated into standard discovery.

The matter was discussed at the Litigation Section meeting of September 26<sup>th</sup>. Following discussion, the sense of the group was that such production should not be automatically required, but rather, the need for such production should be considered on a case-by-case basis.

This position was considered and approved as an official Section position at the October meeting of the CBA's Legislative Policy and Review Committee.
