The Board of Managers met and discussed the issue presented regarding hybrid representation and we propose to add the following language to the proposed language set forth attached to rule 3-8(a):

"Except as otherwise provided for in section 3-8(B)." [This is the provision that discusses the ability to file a limited appearance]

Therefore, the full new rule as proposed with their addition in bold and ours in italics would read as follows:

"Whenever an attorney files an appearance for a party, or the party files an appearance for himself or herself, and there is already an appearance of an attorney or party on file for that party, the attorney or party filing the new appearance shall state thereon whether such appearance is in place of or in addition to the appearance or appearances already on file except that there shall be no appearance entered for both an attorney and a self-represented party without the express permission of the presiding judge for good cause shown except as otherwise provided for in section 3-8(B) below.
