Hi Linda-

I submitted a rule change that would allow a defendant who is hospitalized to have his/her presence waived and to be arraigned by the court for good cause shown. As you can see in my letter, this would allow for the court to issue orders of protection (or no contact in a non-dv situation). It would also allow victims to be present in court while the matter was heard. When a defendant is arraigned in the hospital, the court orders a transcript of the proceeding, but no victim/victim's family is permitted in the hospital room. By changing the rule, we can address issues in the case earlier rather than waiting for a delayed court appearance.
