On April 27, 2021, the Legal Specialization Screening Committee met and considered the Connecticut Bar Association's renewal application to certify lawyers as specialists in Workers' Compensation law. At the meeting, the Committee recommended the following:

The Legal Specialization Screening Committee recommends that the Connecticut Bar Association be approved for recertification as a certifier in the specialty area of Workers' Compensation law, for a five year period, pursuant to its application dated February 19, 2021, because in the opinion of the Committee, it meets all of the criteria in the rules and as developed by the Committee to evaluate whether entities should be approved as certifiers, subject to the condition that, if approved, the applicant shall be required to notify promptly the Legal Specialization Screening Committee of any material changes in its methodology for certifying lawyers as specialists during the term of its approval.
