



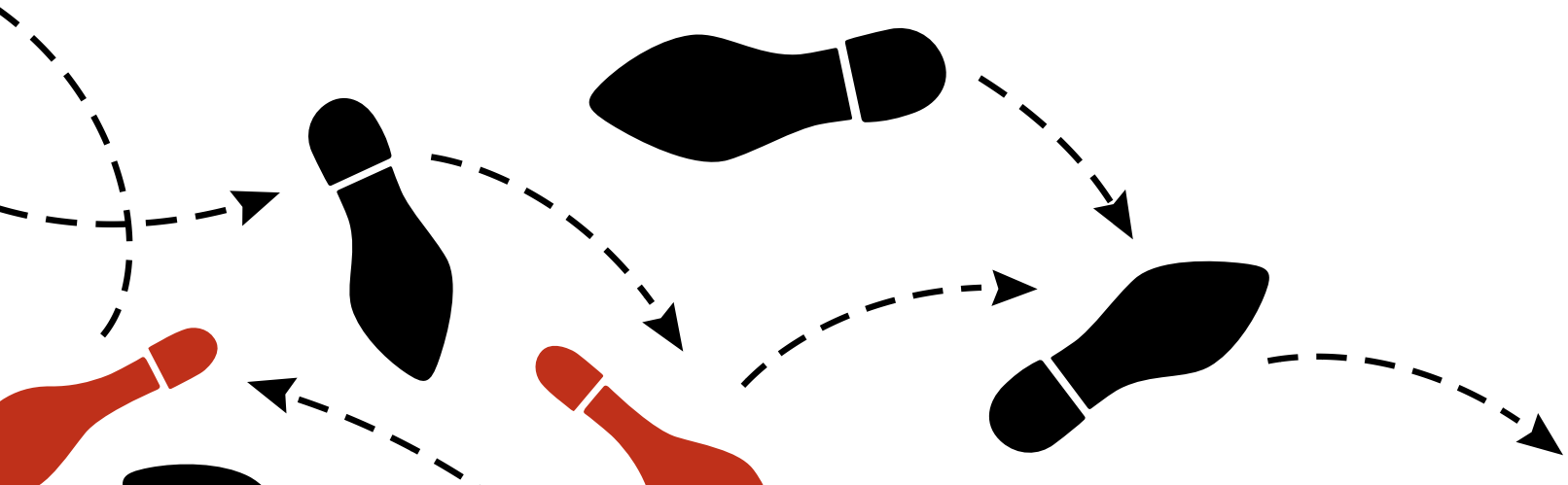
LINE DANCING FOR LAWYERS

LOGO GUIDE

Several of our sponsorship packages and other opportunities include representation on signage or other promotional materials. Below are guidelines for what we need from you to ensure your logo looks its best.

Logo File Options:



Best:

Ai (Adobe Illustrator) or EPS File

File name will end in .ai or .eps, such as ourlogo.eps.

Why it's best:

Ai or EPS files can be scaled infinitely large without ever losing quality. They also have a transparent background which allows for more flexibility when designing.



Next best:

A Large, High-Resolution JPEG or PDF File

File name will end in .jpg or .pdf

Specs:

- 200-300 DPI

AND

- At least 8-10 inches in size at the longest edge.

How to Check DPI and Dimensions

1. Right-click on the file.
2. Go to "properties" or "get info."
3. Click on "details" or "more info."
4. The DPI and dimensions will be here.



Will Not Work:

Logos taken from a website are designed to be small and will usually be low resolution and not suitable for printing. These files will be PNGs or small JPEGs (file name ending in .png or .jpg).

If the logo looks small on screen, blurry when you zoom in, and/or it is a very small file size (roughly under 700kb), it will not work for printing purposes.



We may occasionally need a larger file, but usually the "next best" or "best" category will work. Please send your logo whenever it is redesigned to TJennings@ctbar.org.
